POUR

- **Perceivable:** All aspects of your site or document are viewable
- **Operable:** Works with alternative user controls
- **Understandable:** Content is consistent and clear
- **Robust:** Content acts similar across platforms

Websites

- Use H1, H2, and H3
- Meet color contrast guidelines: 4.5:1
- Create alternate text for all images
- Avoid “click here” links

Documents


- Format with Styles, not bold and italics
- Meet color contrast guidelines: 4.5:1
- Use a sans serif font no smaller than size 11pt
- Provide alternate text for images

Media and Multimedia

- Images must have alternate text
- Video with no audio must have an alternative or an audio track that provides equivalent information
- Audio must have an alternative, such as captions or a transcript, that shows all auditory information (including important sounds)
- Caption all multimedia (video with synchronized audio)
