



**Important Note:** The formalization of these definitions does not change the Provost Office's existing policy that approximately 90% of all courses at the University will be taught in person. All decisions about changing modalities for specific courses must include consultation with and approval by the relevant program directors, department heads, and deans.

What is the course mode listed in StudentAdmin?

**The instructor will *always* be in the classroom**

- In Person** → Students will always be in the same room as peers and instructor
- In Person Remote** → Some students will be in the room with the instructor. Some will attend from a remote location.

**The instructor will be in the classroom *some of the time***

- Hybrid** → Students will be *in the classroom* more often than not. Other instruction and learning occurs online.
- Hybrid Limited** → Students will *learn online* more often than not. There will be limited in-person attendance

**The instructor won't be in the classroom *at all***

- Online Synchronous** → Students will attend all classes online on a fixed day and time
- Online Asynchronous** → Students will access course activities and materials on their own schedule
- Online Blended** → Students will attend some classes online on fixed days and times. Other times, students access activities and materials on their own schedule.
